## HISTORY

**B**uilt in 1908-1909 by the architect and landscaper Henri Martinet (who designed the Shinjuku Gyoen gardens in Tokyo), from the moment it opened the Hôtel Ermitage received aristocrats and distinguished families including the Schlumbergers, Singers and the Countess of Castellane. Originally a hotel until the 1930s, it was transformed into a hospital in 1950 and subsequently became a renal centre in 1967.

It was bought in 1991 by the Evian Mineral Water Company, and further to careful refurbishment inspired by the surrounding nature, was returned to its initial purpose. In 2010, the hotel was completely renovated by interior designer Patrick Ribes, advised by the designer Delphine Chaumon Aidan, which gave it its current-day identity: a warm and intimate atmosphere for cosy stays that strengthen ties.



## AN INVITING *friendly atmosphere*

**H**ôtel Ermitage is a charming property with an Anglo-Normand architectural style and 80 rooms and family suites. Located at the heart of the Evian Resort, guests enjoy access to a host of activities to suit everyone, whatever their age or preferences.

With its impressive open fireplace which stands prominently at the reception and its cosy feel in winter, and outdoor terrace facing the lake throughout the rest of the year, Hôtel Ermitage is undeniably a place where it is easy to let go. A place for happy times together in a laid-back ambience. This is the appeal of this 4-star hotel that combines warmth and authenticity to perfection, just like a family home.

The decoration features natural materials and understated lines combined with raw elements such as wood, stone and leather. Hues of brown, plant patterns and subtle blends of colour all create references to nature. The bathrooms have been designed using mineral materials in shades of grey and taupe. Pebbles and slate work with transparency to retrace the history of water and its journey from the mountains to the spring.
